The University of Wyoming College of Education is excited to announce cohort 2 of the Wyoming Teacher Mentor Corps. This program is designed to support excellence in mentorship for Wyoming educators and develop a community of educator fellows who can support each other and those who are new to the field.

We invite nominations of Wyoming teachers who are committed to their own professional growth and development and the growth and development of other professional educators. In addition, nominees should have the ability to work collaboratively with large groups and be able to manage their commitments and balance their work/life.

Nominees must commit to:

- Attending a three-day summer institute June 2023
- Attend a two-day fall retreat September/October 2023
- Attend a two-day spring retreat March/April 2024
- Attend a follow-up three-day summer institute June 2024
- Attend a two-day fall retreat September/October 2024
- Participate in completion ceremony at fall 2024 retreat
- Mentor a(n) novice or relatively new teacher, a teacher new to the building or district, or a student teacher
- Participate in regular community of practice virtual gatherings (synchronously and asynchronously) throughout the duration of the cohort

The College of Education commits to:

- Provide high quality professional learning opportunities relating to mentorship
- Cover the cost for all participant travel to all WTMC events
- Cover the cost of substitute teachers while Mentor Fellows are attending WTMC events
- Be responsive to questions, comments, or concerns of any Mentor Fellow or their immediate supervisor.
- Provide opportunities for continuing education credit based on Mentor Fellows' engagement in the program.

The Nomination period opens Tuesday, January 3, 2023, and extends until January 20, 2023, at 4:00 pm. Any educator, administrator, student, parent, school board or community member can nominate an educator to be a Wyoming Mentor Corps Fellow. Self-Nominations are also welcome. We encourage a wide variety of individuals with a wide variety of professional experiences and backgrounds.

A final Recommendation for Participation survey link will be sent to the principal/immediate supervisors of those nominees who accept their nomination. Only those nominees who complete the Acceptance of Nomination survey AND whose principals/immediate supervisors complete the Recommendation for Participation survey will be considered for acceptance into the WTMC.

Once all surveys are completed, the Wyoming Teacher Mentor Corps Selection committee will review the documentation submitted to determine who will be accepted into cohort 2 of the Wyoming Teacher Mentor Corps.
